SHOWCASING SHADOW & APARTMENT MARKET DATA

HousingLink's first-ever earned-income venture was created in 2011! Twin Cities Rental Revue is a subscriber-based quarterly report that reveals market rate rental information for both the apartment and shadow (house, duplex, condo, townhome) markets.

Generated \$11,200 in ongoing revenue (so far!) from 25 subscribers.

Provides new insight into the Shadow Market, revealing its large impact on rental housing.
