

Housing Choice Voucher (HCV)/Section 8 Waiting list St. Louis Park, MN

Online applications will be available:
Tuesday, March 18, 2025 at 8 a.m. through
Thursday, March 20, 2025 at 4:30 p.m.

Applications will be accepted online only during this period at <https://housing.slpmn.us>. Translation is available in 60 different languages. **Applications will not be available in the Housing Authority (HA) offices, and fax or e-mail requests will not be accepted. The HA will not provide telephone assistance for applications.** Applicants needing a reasonable accommodation should submit a written request to the HA at 5005 Minnetonka Blvd, St. Louis Park, MN 55416. Computers for public use are available at public libraries and may be available at other community organizations.

Preference Eligibility

- Residency preference: Live, work, hired to work, or attend K-12 school in St. Louis Park, MN
- Elderly, near-elderly (age 50 or older) or disabled preference
- Veteran’s or service person preference: Veteran or member of the armed services, widow/widower of veteran

Foster Youth Independence Initiative (FYI) preference:

- This preference is given to eligible youth referred by Hennepin County with a history of child welfare involvement that are homeless or at risk of being homeless and are seeking to participate in the FYI program.

The HCV/Section 8 program provides rent assistance to households with very low incomes. In order to qualify, the annual gross household income cannot exceed:

Applications must meet income and eligibility requirements. The HA will place 250 applicants on the waiting list through a random drawing from all applications received. If over 250 applications are received, the HA will reserve 95% of waiting list placements for applicants who live, work or attend school (K-12) full-time in St. Louis Park. The remaining waiting list placements will be chosen using a random sort of all remaining applicants. Applicants can only be on **one** application.
